You will study Italian language, usually in the morning, in a class where the minimum age is fifty.

We offer Italian tuition from Elementary to Advanced level.

The classroom approach is to create an informal atmosphere for purposeful learning, conducted at a pace suitable for those who may not have been in a classroom for many years.

Our friendly and approachable teachers will make the classes interesting and enjoyable and will use modern teaching methods and materials to build your confidence in speaking Italian.

Group activities will be arranged to improve your comprehension and communication skills, such as guided and free conversation practice, role play and discussion of aspects of Italian life, customs and culture.



ACTIVITIES

Florence is one of the world's most beautiful cities with its historical centre classified as a UNESCO World Heritage site. In a relatively small area Florence contains a wealth of Renaissance art treasures among streets that were once walked by their great creators like Michelangelo, Botticelli and Leonardo Da Vinci. Outside the classroom, you will have the benefit of guided visits to sites of cultural interest, famous museums, academies, monuments, churches, gardens and historic villas. Moreover, you will have the chance to attend one of the most important musical events of the Italian Opera.

Linguaviva's programme proposes classic excursions to discover the fascinating mix of history, culture art and scenery for which Tuscany is universally famous. All excursions are supervised by the Linguaviva teachers. While staying in Florence participants can have the possibility of discovering the secrets of Italian cuisine and wine undertaking a class at one of the most renowned cooking school in Florence.
